headteacher@springfield.sheffield.sch.uk along with your child's name and class. Texts and emails will then be sent to anyone who needs to isolate as a result of a positive case.

This email will be checked daily until 24th December. After that date, you should follow normal testing protocols and do not need to inform school.

However, if your child, or anyone in your household tests positive for Covid 19, please ensure everyone has completed the isolation periods before returning to school.

School closes today, Friday 18th December. We wish all our families a Happy and healthy New Year and look forward to welcoming you all back on Monday 4th January 2021.
