Welcome to the **Summer edition** of our Sheffield CU Passport Activity Newsletter. It's packed with fun activities happening during the Summer holidays. In here you'll find activities taking place across the city in the school holidays – from circus skills, cookery, horse-riding and multi-sports, to music, woodland adventures, drama singing and dance. From creative writing, science, gaming, arts, crafts and the Summer Reading Challenge, to budgeting, theme parks, first aid, coding, robotics, game and App design! Phew! This is a bumper edition!

If your child has a Passport to Learning, they'll be able to earn CU credits for taking part in all of them! You can buy a Passport to Learning (£3.50) from any Sheffield Library (if you attend a Sheffield School or are a member of our Home Education scheme). Some of the activities are FREE while some will need to be paid for, and some require booking in advance.

During 2020 and 2021, we published daily CU Home Learning Challenges and we reached **98** of them by the end of the school year then continued to create even more! The great news is that they're all still available for you to download and complete, so have a look for the links to access them on the next page. There is information on how you can claim CU credits for completing these challenges if you normally attend a Sheffield school and have a Passport to Learning. There's a brand new Fundraising Challenge this time too. If you see challenges published by other CUs, then do feel free to complete them. 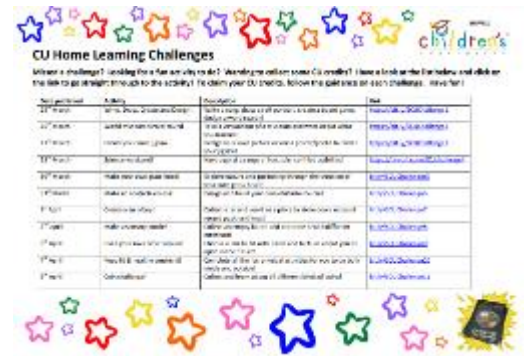


# Home Learning Challenges!

# Challenge: Fabulous Fundraiser

Raising funds for a special cause is a great way to use your skills to help others. Perhaps you might want to raise funds for a local charity? Maybe there's a national charity which is special to you? There are LOADS of ways you could be a fundraiser...either by yourself or as part of a group. Here's some steps to help you get going and remember to send us a copy of the second page so we can award your CU credits. Perhaps you could take part in an organised sponsored activity? Maybe you could organise a whole fundraising event?

**Step 1:** Decide which charity, organisation or cause you'd like to raise funds for. Can you find out information about who they are and what they do to support others? How might they use the money you raise?



**Step 2:** Ask an adult to help you plan and deliver your fundraiser activity, or join an existing fundraising event. Will this be a one-off event or activity, or something which takes place over a longer period? What type of activity will you do? A sponsored walk, jog, run, cycle? A fundraising party? Bucket collections at events? Ask your adult to check any important things, such as signing up to an event, asking permission to collect money at events, etc.

**Step 3:** Time to get planning! Where and when will the fundraising take place? How will you be involved? Which adult will be responsible for collecting and paying in the money raised? How will you tell people about your fundraising, and encourage them to get involved? Have a great time...fundraising can be LOTS of fun!

**Step 4:** Complete your fundraising challenge! It might not be easy, so try and think about all the money you're raising when it's most difficult. Remember to take photos – we'd love to see them!

**Step 5:** Time to collect in the cash. Ask an adult to help you with this. Then ask them to pay it into the charity or organisation safely. Well done you!

**Step 6:** Remember to claim your CU credits by sending us a copy of your Fundraising Record (on the next page). Ask an adult to email it to [CU@sheffield.gov.uk](mailto:CU@sheffield.gov.uk) and remember to send photos too...we LOVE to see your fundraising in action! You can earn **2 CU Credits** each time you complete this challenge.

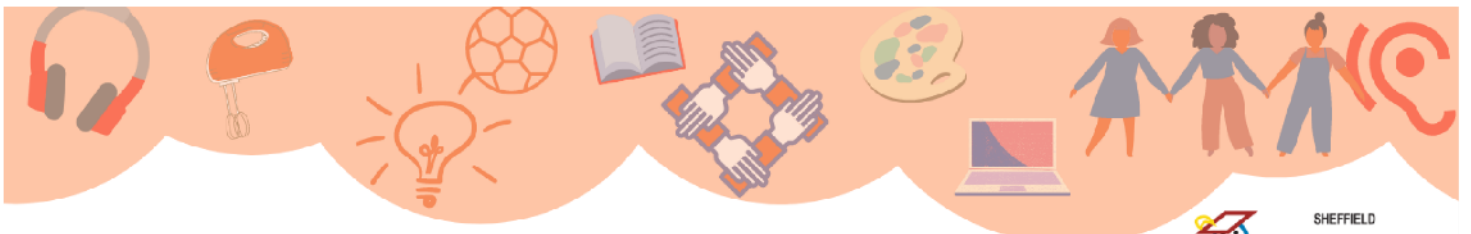

**Buy one from your local Sheffield library - £3.50 each**



Visit [www.sheffield.gov.uk/libraries](http://www.sheffield.gov.uk/libraries) to find details of your nearest library and their opening hours



We recommend giving them a call to check they have Passports to Learning in stock before making a special journey



Pop along, buy your CU Passport to Learning, then a parent/carer must sign the consent sticker inside



Before you leave, why not ask Library staff about the activities they run? You can earn CU credits at them!

Can't get to a library? Don't worry, you can buy one online directly from us (£4.50 inc. postage to home address) <https://bit.ly/SCUOrderPassporttoLearning>

\*please note: limited access to our office means there will be a slight delay (upto 4 weeks) in you receiving your Passport but we'll get it to you as soon as we can!

Please note: pupils **MUST** attend a SHEFFIELD school (or be a subscribing member of our CU Home Education package) to buy a Sheffield CU Passport to Learning.

# VISITING A LEARNING DESTINATION BEYOND SHEFFIELD?



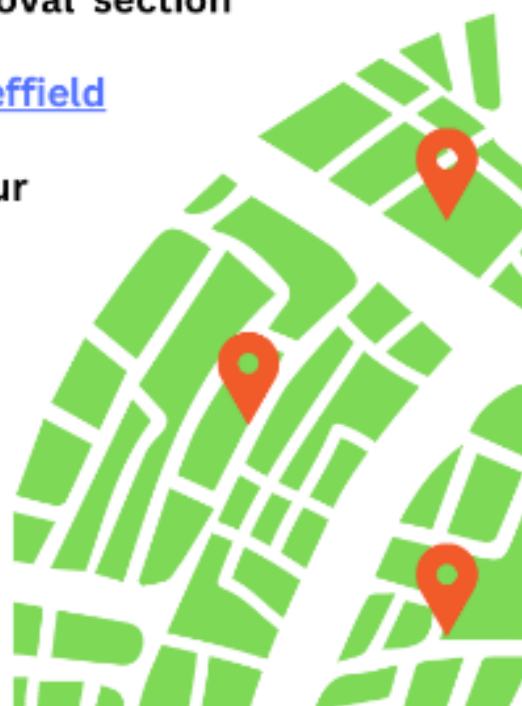
THERE'S A NEW WAY TO CLAIM YOUR CU CREDITS...

1. Get your Passport to Learning signed by the Learning Destination
2. Make sure they include the CU ACTIVITY CODE...a colour and 4 numbers...e.g. **RED1234**...in the 'stamp of approval' section
3. Visit <https://bit.ly/claimSCUcreditsbeyondSheffield>
4. Complete the information online including your details and the Activity Stamp Code
5. Our team will award your credits

\*PLEASE NOTE: children MUST attend a Sheffield school (or be a subscribing member of our Home Education programme) AND have a CU Passport to Learning to collect CU credits at validated Learning Destinations. Learning Destinations can be found at: [www.childrensuniversity.co.uk/activity-search](http://www.childrensuniversity.co.uk/activity-search)

Sheffield CU does NOT use CU Online to track credits. Don't worry, your child WILL NOT have been given a log in or password details for CU Online.

CU credits earned at Sheffield-based Learning Destinations will continue to be recorded viaCU register as normal.

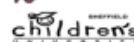

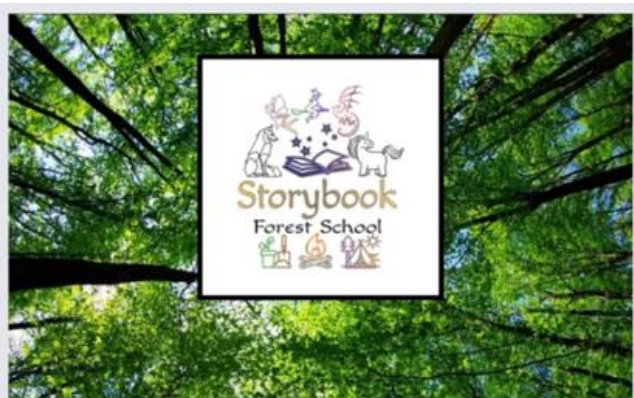
