### STAFF NEWS

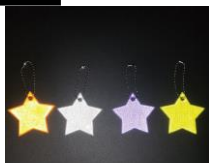
We are pleased to welcome some new members of staff. Miss Charlesworth has joined us and Mrs Al-Yahani has returned. They are both working as Teaching Assistants.
