Term: Summer 2		Theme: Theme: Geography — Countries and continents.		
Key Questions: Where is Kampong Ayer? What is the climate like? What is it like to live there? How is it different to the UK? What is the main faith/Language?		Stimulus: (Book/ Visit/ etc) Text: Tinga-Tinga Tales, Mufaro Beautiful Daughters, The Girl that did some baking.		
As Writers we will: Write stories and sentences, focussing on capital letters, finger spaces and full-stops. We will learn about the plural rules for spelling and what verbs and adjectives are. We will continue to practise our key word spellings, reading and listening to stories that are set in different countries. Looking at different cultures. We will be using these as inspiration for retelling these stories and writing our own stories. We will also be writing recounts, instructions, and information texts. We will continue to do daily phonics practising decoding and finding digraphs in words. We will be looking at more complex word structures which include 2 syllable words. As Mathematicians we will: Count from 50 to 100. We will be able to say 1 more and 1 less from a given number. We will be practising counting in 2s, 5s, 10s. We will recognise and understand ordinal numbers. We will be partitioning into tens and ones and be able to count on a number line. We will compare any 2 numbers. We will be learning how to unitise. We will recognise coins and notes and be able to count coins. We will be practising saying the days of the week and months of the year. We will understand language of before and after. We will be learning about hours, minutes, and seconds. We will be practising telling the time to the hour and half hour.		As Artists we will: Roll paper to make 3D structures. We will shape paper to make a 3D drawing. We will apply paper-shaping skills to make an imaginative sculpture. We will work collaboratively to plan and create a sculpture. We will apply our painting skills when working in 3D. We will be able to describe the works of Louise Bourgeois and create sculptures using natural or manmade materials.		As Computer Engineers we will: We will be comparing different programming tools. We will be using joining blocks in programs to run our own program. We will make changes where needed. We will be able to add sprites to our programmes. We will design our project and choose appropriate artwork for our project. We will create an algorithm for each sprite. We will create our projects on screen in Scratch. We will test our programs we have created As Musicians we will: Listen and appraise pieces of music. We will be able to join in with musical activities. We will be able to learn songs and chants. We will be able to use our voices expressively to singing and chanting.
