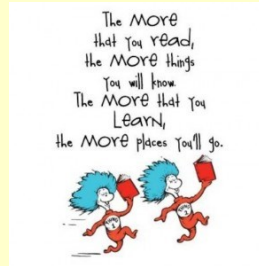

Gold Readers this term!

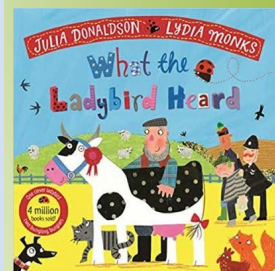

- Year 6: 82%

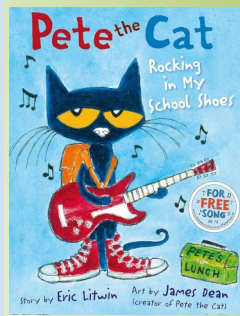

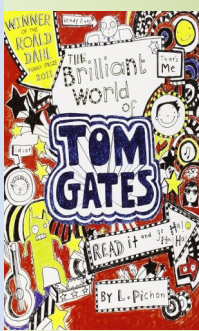

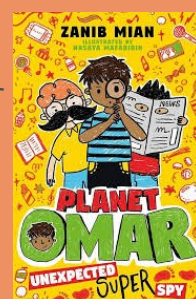
Author of the term
