Term: Spring 2		Theme: Animals		
Key Questions: What are the different types of Animal groups? What features do these animals have? What are the changes we see happen in Spring? How are these changes different to Winter?		Stimulus: (Book/ Visit/ etc) Text: I love Animals Jaspers Beanstalk Titch Monkey Puzzle		
As Writers we will: Write stories and sentences, focussing on capital letters, finger spaces and full-stops. We will identify and write personal pronouns as subjects as well as Identify and write personal pronouns as objects. We will be able to use a capital letter for the personal pronoun P. reading and watching stories about Animals. We will be writing to inform by fact finding and writing facts about animals. We will continue to practise our key word spellings.		As Artists we will: Be able to understand what a sculpture is. We will be creating our own sculptures and thinking about design and shape.	As Designers: N/A	As Computer Engineers we will: Continue to learn to log on to a computer and use our own passwords. We will learn what an algorithm is and how to create our own. We will be using the Bee bots to give directions and find out cause and effect.
As Mathematicians we will: Read, write and interpret mathematical statements involving addition (+), subtraction (-) and equals (=) signs. Read and write numbers from 1 to 20 in numerals and words. Given a number, identify one more and one less. Identify and represent numbers using objects and pictorial representations including the number line, and use the language of: equal to, more than, less than (fewer), most, least. We will use number lines to 20 to support working out – and + equations. We will work on our number bonds to 20.				As Musicians we will: learn songs and chants linked to our texts. We will be using our voices expressively to sing and chant. We will be finding the pulse of different pieces of music. We will be learning a song which is in the style of Latin music.
