# Phonics Testing



This is because in the Summer term 2020.

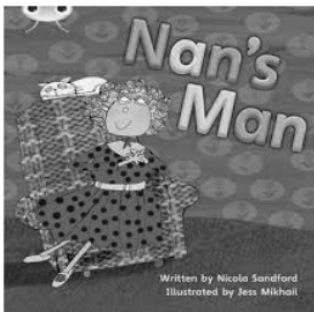
Each child will be having Year 1 Phonics Screening which involves asking the children to read number of words to an adult.

It is done in a controlled environment where one child goes to be assessed (about 10 - 15 minutes)

Before the summer we will be tracking your child before the Screening and give them the necessary resources they may need to be successful.

There are a number of ways to help your child:

- Read with your child for around 10 minutes everyday.
- Write the title of the book in their Reading Record and sign it.
- Listen to them read the Guided Reading book.
- Ask them to sound talk unfamiliar words.
- Practice spellings everyday, some words have the phonemes we have been learning that week.



Please keep the booklets at home so your child can look at them and get lots of practice reading them.

If you have the internet at home and your child has access to it logging on to these sites are helpful too.
